We understand the risks of sending our camper with peanut/nut allergies to Camp Cedar Cliff. We also understand that Camp Cedar Cliff does not provide or prepare special diets and that peanut products may be served at meals and during snack times. If the camper's medical situation, due to his/her allergies, becomes unmanageable in the camp setting and poses a risk to the camper or to Camp Cedar Cliff, the Camp Director reserves the right to send a camper home.

In consideration of being permitted to attend camp at Camp Cedar Cliff, we, the undersigned, hereby release and forever discharge Camp Cedar Cliff, Inc. all actions and causes of action, rights, suits, judgments, claims and demands whatsoever in law or equity, including claims for contribution, arising from and by reason of any and all known and unknown, foreseen and unforeseen bodily and personal injuries or death, and the consequences related in any way to any allergy to peanut/nut products or any reactions thereto, including but not limited to any liability caused by the negligence or fault of Camp Cedar Cliff, Inc. or their agents or employees in that connection while the undersigned camper is present at Camp Cedar Cliff, Inc.
